Although death is usually a shunned topic, we must admit that from the moment we were born, we have been moving slowly but surely towards death. People in this world fear death because they are afraid that it will take them to an unknown place, and they will forever be separated from their loved ones. In response, we are delighted to share with you the true meaning of death based on God's words in the Bible.

Firstly, what is the origin of death? You may think that it's part of nature to experience birth, aging, illness and death. But in fact, death is brought on by human sin: So sin is the cause and death is the result. "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned" (Romans 5:12).
